Statement on Vaccination Policy

With the State borders due to be opened to Eastern State and International travellers, the Committee has discussed measures required to protect attendees and members, against Covid19 infection, particularly those most at risk. These measures are based entirely on current [Government Guidelines](#).

From the 31st January 2022:

Double vaccination will be the entry requirement for members and attendees at any and all Perth International Dance sessions/events. This includes PID-sponsored events/sessions.

The vaccination certification status of all members/attendees will need to be -

- **Viewed by the undersigned (or nominated representative), or**
- **Sent by email to the undersigned.**

A secure register of members/attendees whose certificate I (or a nominated person) have sighted will be maintained, to obviate the need to check on an ongoing basis.

Should government guidelines change, for example, if boosters are required, then vaccination status will need to be reviewed.

The following additional measures will continue as per Government Guidelines:

- Masks to be worn as per current guidelines.
- No hand holding during sessions.
- Use of the Hand Sanitiser provided
- Please bring your own cups for refreshment breaks.

Covid-19 affects different people in different ways and most will recover without hospitalisation.

Serious symptoms require immediate medical intervention.

Mild symptoms in people who are otherwise healthy should manage their symptoms at home.

DO NOT COME TO DANCING SESSIONS IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING ANY RESPIRATORY SYMPTOMS OR FEELING UNWELL.

The Committee will continue to monitor and advise members of the impact of any changes, and events as they unfold with the opening of the borders.
