### **3 Treasurers Report**

- First 3 months of classes roughly broken even, partly because Sara was teaching in January and brought lots of Israeli dancers along. About \$50 down
- Membership #'s – down but to be confirmed by email – not reported
- FDA not yet requested renewal, **John W.** may have to follow up

- New lesson format report – John
  - More continuity of action during the lesson, more dances with which people are familiar: less new dances. Positive feedback. Makes for a more energetic feel to the lesson. More dancing and exercise. Reported to other teachers who are interpreting to suit for their own teaching. Suggestions accepted.
